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Did you know?

As related by a foster grandma serving in Blackfoot: "A little boy went to his teacher and wanted to read to her. When he was done, she asked him who had shown him the words. He said, 'Grandma taught me'. He was so proud! The teacher came and gave me a hug and thanked me."

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Did you know?

Last July we helped an indigent patient who came into the clinic with a huge knot on the right side of his face get treatment for an abscessed tooth. Using United Way funds and patient medication assistance programs, we were able to help the patient get the treatment and medication needed to help him regain control of his medical issues.

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Did you know?

The family of a 98 year old mother contacted us. She refused to go into an assisted living facility but was not eating properly and her health was failing. We began delivering

Meals-on-Wheels to her and assisted in getting a home health aide into her home to help with daily living activities. The services our program provides has assisted this lady in staying in her own home for two years now. By eating better her health has improved. We also deliver food from the pantry to her. The additional groceries gives her more money to cover her heating and medication expenses.

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Did you know?

Robin and Joe, both disabled and living on a fixed income, have a son in high school. They are not eligible for food stamps and barely make it month to month without falling behind on their bills. Robin has a degenerative eye disease that requires her to go to University of Utah 4-6 times a year. When needed, United Way dollars help Robin with gas vouchers for her doctor's appoints in Utah. Without this contribution for gasoline from the United Way, Robin's vision would be dwindling more and more every year.

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Did you know?

If children are not reading proficiently by 3rd grade they are **4 times** more likely to drop out and not graduate high school?

Our focus on education includes early learning and grade level reading and partnering with experts in the field.

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Did you know?

Local people benefit from support through literacy; youth development; family/parental education; early childhood development; afterschool programs; mentoring; high school graduation

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Did you know?

\$5 per pay period provides 3 scholarships for a youth sports program each year.

\$10 per pay period provides 12 days of direct mentoring from a trained adult for a student in a high school after-school program.

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Did you know?

\$1 per pay period provides two nights of after school programs for a low-income child.

\$20 per pay period provides workbooks for up to 52 families to support their development of nurturing parenting techniques.

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Did you know?

421 people were provided with emergency shelter locally last year.

Over 86,000 nutritious meals were provided for seniors in our region.

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Did you know?

Local people benefit from support through employment skills training; basic needs support; financial literacy; prescription savings; senior services; homelessness prevention; emergency shelters

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Did you know?

\$5 per pay period provides 55 meals for an elderly, homebound senior.

\$10 per pay period provides food boxes for needy families for three months.

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Did you know?

\$1 per pay period provides one pair of winter boots for a child displaced from home.

\$20 per pay period provides a daily hot meal for a homebound person for six months.

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Did you know?

\$1 per pay period can provide a screening & dental exam, x-rays, fillings or extractions or treatment of an abscess with antibiotics.

\$20 per pay period allows an abused child to receive eight individual counseling sessions.

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Did you know?

\$5 per pay period covers one medical or mental health visit for 12 patients.

\$10 per pay period provides on-site advocacy and support in the emergency room for (5) rape victims.

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Did you know?

Our prescription discount program has saved our community over \$1/2 Million since program began; \$642M nationwide.

Local residents have saved \$149,304 on mental health prescription medications they might not have been able to afford otherwise.

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Did you know?

3—5 people are visiting the local ER every day for dental pain?

We have a 2 year initiative that is addressing children's oral health; offering FREE screening, cleaning, fluoride varnish and dental sealants to grade level students.

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
